At the time of writing the river levels are very high and the parish council is consulting on the community flood evacuation plan. The plan encourages residents to keep themselves informed (and shows them how), ensures that places of flood refuge are ready and ensure that the emergency services will have the correct contact details of those most at risk. All parish households will receive a copy of the final version of the plan in February or you can use the QR code below to view the document now. We encourage residents to familiarise themselves with the contents.
