Happy New Year to you all from us all at the Parish Council. Although we have started the year with another lockdown, with the roll out of the new vaccines, we hope that we will return to a normal soon. If you find yourself self-isolating and need assistance, information or help accessing food or medicine, please contact the parish council as a first port of call. wwe will be happy to help where we can.

In our last article we touched upon the subject of speeding in our parish. Since then, all households within the parish have received a briefing note, illustrating what is happening each area, and requesting a completion of a survey regarding speeding in Severn Stoke. The survey closed on 10th January and we are currently analysing that data and by the time you read this we will have discussed it at our meeting on 20th January, where we hope to agree a plan to tackle this issue. Our thanks go to everyone who took the time to complete the survey, it is important that we understand everyone's views on this difficult to resolve problem.

A topic that takes much time to resolve is the multiple heighways, footpaths & infrastructure issues. Current issues that were discussed at our last meeting with are are the hedge onto A38 from Stonnall Close encroaching the footpath, the conifer hedge (A38/path) at Clifton, the condition of the footpath on the A38 between Clifton and Severn Stoke, the old cricket pavilion at Severn Stoke, sstreetlight disturbance at Knights Hill, the corner nr Croome Arch – dangerous parking, damaged road surface and the issue of accumulating dog waste since NT removal of the dog waste bin, the bin in the lay-by, A38 southbound between Clifton and Severn Stoke, Leitter and state of path along A38, Leose slab in front of High Green noticeboard and finally the footpath steps at Kinnersley. The Parish Council try to resolve these ourselves where applicable or by engaging with the appropriate agencies to implement a resolution in a timely fashion

Unfortunately, one of our councillors has had to resign due to a change in circumstances, so we are looking for a representative for the Croome Ward. If you have an interest in becoming a Parish Councillor, please contact the Parish Clerk in the first instance.
